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








# Argentina

In 1902, Italian immigrant Nicola Catena planted his first vineyard in Mendoza, Argentina. Today, this fourth-generation winery is one of the few remaining family-owned wineries in Argentina, now led by Nicolás Catena and his daughter Laura. Nicolás dared to plant vines where no one thought they would ripen. His high-altitude wine revolution culminated in the discovery of a new terroir for wine, the Adrianna Vineyard, at almost 5,000 feet elevation.

In 2023, Catena Zapata was awarded the #1 World's Best Vineyard.



## Nicolás Catena Zapata 2020



Composition Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, and Cabernet Franc | SRP \$99.99

About the Wine With its inaugural 1997 vintage, Nicolás Catena Zapata became the first luxury cuvée from Argentina to be exported around the world. The wine recreates the "Original Bordeaux Blend" of the 18th and 19th Centuries when Malbec dominated Merlot.

**Tasting Notes** Aromas of black fruit and saline minerality with subtle vanilla and dark chocolate. Tremendously complex and remarkably concentrated, with layers of red currant, eucalyptus, and black pepper.

## Malbec Argentino 2021



Composition 100% Malbec | SRP \$119.99

**About the Wine** Made exclusively from pre-phylloxera selections from the family's Angélica and Nicasia Vineyards. The label pays tribute to the variety's epic history in France and its rise in Argentina. Four female figures embody different landmarks in the history of the grape.

**Tasting Notes** Malbec Argentino combines black fruit and dark berry aromas on the one hand, with gripping, lightly saline flavors of mocha, spice, and minerals on the other.



Certified Sustainable by Bodegas de Argentina Domaine Nico is named after Laura Catena's daughter, Nicola, whose name pays homage to Nicola Catena, Laura's great-grandfather and the founder of Catena Zapata. Laura borrows from France in the names of the wine parcels and the concept of individual terroirs, but she also plays with the words to give the wines a modern twist that reflects their style.

Domaine Nico is the world's first extreme high-altitude parcel Pinot Noir. The fifteen extremely small parcels range from Villa Bastais to Gualtallary in the Uco Valley's Tupungato region. Each low-production microvinification is fermented with indigenous yeasts, and some use whole-cluster fermentation. These wines age in French oak barrels for 18 months prior to bottling.



### Histoire d'A Pinot Noir 2021



Composition 100% Pinot Noir | SRP \$54.99

**About the Wine** Whole cluster fermentation highlights the wine's texture. The greater sun exposure produces a more generous wine, with spice and a perceived sweetness to the tannins.

**Tasting Notes** Spicy and herbal in character, with thyme, cinnamon, black pepper, clove, violet, and cherry aromas. On the palate, it has moderate acidity and a velvety texture. The finish is long, with deep, fresh red fruit flavors.

#### Le Savante Pinot Noir 2021



Composition 100% Pinot Noir | SRP: \$54.99

**About the Wine** "The scholar" in the feminine pays homage to scholarly women. This vertical wine is feminine and serious, with minerality, spicy red fruits, and an earthy character.

**Tasting Notes** Aromas of red fruits, earthy thyme, rosemary, and sweet spices such as clove. It has medium-high acidity, low alcohol, and a slight minerality alongside integrated oak and layered tannins.

#### Le Paradis Pinot Noir 2016



Composition 100% Pinot Noir | SRP \$349.99

**About the Wine** At an elevation of 1500 meters, the cool climate Le Paradis vineyard in Gualtallary Alto feels like paradise itself to Laura. It is lined by trees and fruit orchards with majestic views of the Andes. Inside the 12-hectare vineyard is a little house with two tiny bedrooms and a kitchen, affectionately named Château Laura.

**Tasting Notes** Intense mineral elements such as chalk, with some reduction and herbal notes. A few minutes after opening, berry aromatics appear. Layered and ever-increasing aromas. Subtle, integrated oak with high acidity.

El Enemigo wines are brought to fruition by Chief Winemaker Alejandro Vigil and Historian Adrianna Catena who seek to honor the European immigrants and winemakers who first settled in Argentina. Alejandro Vigil is a soil expert, a winemaker, and an animal lover. Adrianna Catena, daughter of Nicolás Catena, continues the family legacy of winemaking while pursuing her passion for history. The Gran Enemigo wines are considered the finest in refinement and aging potential.



## Gran Enemigo Gualtallary 2018



Composition 85% Cabernet Franc, 15% Malbec | SRP \$129.99

**About the Wine** El Gualtallary in Tupungato is a high-density vineyard with calcareous, rocky soil. The grapes are carefully harvested in five [stages] across 45 days. The wine is aged for 16 months in a 100-year-old foudre.

Tasting Notes Rich and profound, with intense aromas of blackberry, wood, olive, and thyme.

## Gran Enemigo Chacayes 2018



Composition 85% Cabernet Franc, 15% Malbec | SRP \$129.99

**About the Wine** Los Chacayes in Tunuyán is a high-density vineyard with alluvial soil and limestone. The grapes are carefully harvested in five [stages] across 45 days. The wine is aged for 18 months in a 100-year-old foudre.

**Tasting Notes** This Cabernet Franc is dark and firm, with notes of blueberries, black currants, lavender, tobacco, walnuts, and black peppercorns. The finish has a savory, mineral character.

### Gran Enemigo El Cepillo 2018



Composition 85% Cabernet Franc, 15% Malbec | SRP \$129.99

**About the Wine** El Cepillo in San Carlos is a high-density vineyard with colluvial soil and marine limestone. The grapes are carefully harvested in five passes across 45 days. The wine is aged for 15 months in a 100-year-old foudre.

**Tasting Notes** Ripe plums, blackberries, and cherries on the nose, with hints of dried mint, black pepper, cloves, and cocoa. Intense and well-structured, with a medium body and well-integrated tannins.

### Gran Enemigo Torrontes 2019



Composition 100% Torrontés | SRP \$74.99

**About the Wine** Gran Enemigo Torrontés is grown in the Gualtallary vineyards in Tupungato. The grapes are fermented in clay amphoras for then days using wild yeast prior to aging for 18 months in French oak.

**Tasting Notes** Refined minerality with notes of lime and white flowers. This wine boasts an impressive finish.

At the end of the journey, we remember only one battle: the one we fought against ourselves, the original enemy, the one that defined us.

Founded in 1856, Cousiño Macul is the only winery in Chile established during the 19th century that still belongs entirely to the founding family. At age 37, Isidora Cousiño single-handedly fulfilled her late husband's dream of owning and operating a premier Chilean winery. A passion for wine still unites the family after more than 150 years and seven generations, and Isidora's great-great-granddaughter, Verónica Cousiño, joined the winery in 2008.

Cousiño Macul's vines are ungrafted and come from massal selections from their own nursery. This has allowed for the preservation of valuable genetic material, initially brought to Chile by Luis Cousiño in 1860, including Cabernet and Merlot varieties from Pauillac in Haut-Medoc and Sauvignon Gris from Martillac in Graves.



#### Lota 2019



Composition 65% Cabernet Sauvignon and 35% Merlot | SRP \$99.99

**About the Wine** Lota comes from the oldest Cabernet (1932) and best Merlot of Cousiño Macul vineyards at the foot of the Andes. With a natural yield of around 4 tons per hectare, the wines are concentrated and complex.

**Tasting Notes** Aromas of dark fruit with cassis, with hints of cedar and spice. Full-bodied and elegant with luscious flavors of blackberry, currant, cocoa, soft oak, and warm spices. A core of concentrated and delicious black fruits is framed by light toasty oak and ripe tannins, which continues into a long, ultrasmooth finish.

Founded in 1993, TerraNoble produces modern wines with an incredible precision of style and elegant flavors that express the unique terroir of Chile. CA1 and CA2 represent and showcase Carmenere by accentuating the influence of the Andes Mountains and Pacific Ocean, respectively. Under similar vinification and aging conditions, they highlight the impact of Chile's powerful natural forces.



#### CA1 2020



Composition 100% Carmenere | SRP \$34.99

**About the Wine** CA1 is made with grapes from Los Lingues vineyard at the foothills of the Andes Mountains in the Colchagua Valley. Where the Andes meet with the Coastal Range, they create a corridor of wind that maintains a constant temperature ideal for slow ripening.

**Tasting Notes** CA1 is a Carmenere of great character and power. The round tannins and intense aromas of ripe red fruit reveal the best expression of Carmenere grown at the foot of the Andes Mountains.



Composition 100% Carmenere | SRP \$34.99

**About the Wine** CA2 is made with grapes from TerraNoble's vineyard in Marchigue, Colchagua Valley. The area's temperate Mediterranean climate benefits from the coast's constant, refreshing breezes.

**Tasting Notes** CA2 offers refreshing elegance, soft textures, and intense dark fruit and spice flavors. This vibrant wine shows the perfect expression of Carmenere's varietal character from Chile's Costa zone.

**About the Wine** Smooth in texture and full of verve, Matthews' wines offer a balanced palate with a complexity and richness that pairs well with the season's freshest harvest. This wine represents the broad flavors and aromatic expressions of Washington State Cabernet Sauvignon.

**Tasting Notes** Spiced black plum and cocoa nib aromas lead to flavors of dark berries and cedar. Ripe tannins frame the luxuriously broad and balanced palate, and the finish is long and quenching.

## Matthews Sauvignon Blanc 2022



Composition 100% Sauvignon Blanc | SRP \$34.99

**About the Wine** This Sauvignon Blanc is crafted from select vineyards in the Horse Heaven Hills of the Columbia Valley. Fermentation techniques were selected individually for each vineyard to help accentuate the fruit and typicity from each location.

**Tasting Notes** Intense aromatics of starfruit, juicy green pear, and mandarin orange open to honeysuckle and linden flower. This medium-bodied, balanced wine has refreshing flavors of lemon curd, oyster shell, candied orange peel, and flint, followed by a long, textural finish.

**Tasting Notes** Aromas of fresh rosemary, mulberry, violets, and exotic spices. A wine of great complexity with flavors of blackcurrant, bitter chocolate, and mulberries, wrapped in divine tannins and a lovely sweet, dark fruit finish.

## The Signature Cabernet-Shiraz 2019



Composition 52% Cabernet Sauvignon, 48% Shiraz | SRP \$69.99

About the Wine Each vintage of The Signature is named in honor of an individual who has made a significant contribution to the culture and traditions of Yalumba. The 2019 vintage honors Vini & Viti—Kevin Glastonbury, Yalumba Winemaker & Robin Nettelbeck, Chief Viticulturist

**Tasting Notes** Seductive and alluring florals, cool mints, red pomegranate with fine blackberry fruits and dark cherry aromas. The palate is delightfully generous with dark red cherry fruit that merges into ironstone tannins.

PEWSEY VALE VIDEOS The Pewsey Vale Vineyard was established at Eden Valley in 1847, producing some of Australia's first cool climate wines. Today, Pewsey Vale is considered one of the great Riesling vineyards of the world. Here exists a true alliance between nature and variety. The need for human intervention is minimal; gentle guiding hands and an understanding of place are all that are needed to create consistent and delicious wines, vintage after vintage.

The complex Contours Riesling is produced from old vines farmed on the coolest slope of the vineyard and bottled aged for 10 years before release.



## The Contours Riesling 2016



Composition 100% Riesling | SRP \$38.99

**About the Wine** The Contours Riesling is produced from old vines farmed on the coolest slope within this ruggedly beautiful single vineyard. Bottle ageing for five years before release transforms this Riesling into a complex wine.

**Tasting Notes** Bottle aged characters of toast, clove oil, lemongrass, and fresh citrus. The palate has great length and depth with concentrated power and fresh, lime juice with toasted brioche, sage oil, and lime marmalade.

## 1961 Block Riesling 2022



Composition 100% Riesling | SRP \$29.99

**About the Wine** A new interpretation of Riesling from a historic vineyard. Old vine, handpicked, wild fermented and briefly aged on lees.

**Tasting Notes** This wine is pristine and intense with aromas and flavors of lemon myrtle and tea tree blossom. With crushed quartz minerality, it is evocative, seamless, and ageless.

## Coal River Chardonnay 2022



Composition 100% Chardonnay | SRP \$82.99

**About the Wine** Handpicked and whole bunch pressed. The juice is placed into French oak puncheons and a ceramic egg for fermentation. Lees stirring is used for 3 months until most of the malolactic fermentation is completed. Aged 8 months prior to blending and bottling.

**Tasting Notes** The aroma is an alluring combination of mandarins and lemon with white peach, oyster shell, and flint. The palate is defined by delicate citrus fruit with a saline texture from exposure to the southern sea air and a finish that lingers.

#### Coal River Pinot Noir 2021



Composition 100% Pinot Noir | SRP \$82.99

**About the Wine** Magic happens when the right elements collide. In this case, Coal River Valley's plentiful sunshine, low rainfall and drying winds result in bright blue fruit flavors, soft tannins and bright acidity.

**Tasting Notes** Alluring aromas of red cherries, forest floor, licorice, and flint adorn purple raspberry and violets. The palate is layered with plump red berries and spice, tightly wound by fine natural acidity and silky tannins.

Shaw + Smith was established in 1989 by cousins Martin Shaw and Michael Hill Smith. Michael had just completed his Master of Wine in the UK, and Martin was running a "flying winemaker" business in Europe when they decided—somewhat on a whim—to make wine together. While a family business, Shaw + Smith is more about a partnership of two cousins with a unified vision and complimentary skills, now joined by a small team of bright, talented people who are dedicated to taking the business forward. Shaw + Smith aims to make exciting, refined wines exclusively from the Adelaide Hills that rank amongst Australia's best. They specialize in varieties suited to the cooler climate region, namely Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Shiraz.



## Lenswood Chardonnay 2021



Composition 100% Chardonnay | SRP \$84.99

**About the Wine** A fine boned Chardonnay that reflects the conditions of the vintage and the character of this unique vineyard site.

**Tasting Notes** Restrained on the nose, with white flowers and a touch of struck match. A long, fine, and delicate palate but with underlying intensity of fruit, with chamomile, lemon pith and slightly under-ripe nectarine notes.

#### Balhannah Shiraz 2020



Composition 100% Shiraz | SRP \$84.99

**About the Wine** A complex, finely textured Shiraz expressing the conditions of each vintage and the character of a unique vineyard site.

**Tasting Notes** A complex nose with fennel seed, spiced plum, and dried sage notes with tannins that are long, ripe, and even. A wine with huge ageing potential, but delicious as a young wine as well.

The Pikes estate is situated in the picturesque Polish Hill sub region of South Australia's beautiful Clare Valley. Brothers Andrew and Neil Pike established Pikes Wines in 1984 and continue to manage every aspect of the business today. They take great pride in producing quality handcrafted wines that reflect vintage, variety and region. Pikes flagship wine is Riesling Traditionale which has gained an international cult like following as Australia's best dry Riesling. The Pikes story in South Australia is one rich in history dating back to 1878 when Englishman Henry Pike, Andrew and Neil's great-great grandfather, immigrated to South Australia and established the family brewing business called H. Pike & Co. The company used the English Pike fish on the label, which remains to this day a symbol of Pike's long heritage, now spanning three centuries.




### The Merle Riesling 2022

**Tasting Notes** Lifted citrus notes, vibrant florals, and a brown lime focus. Juicy lime medley with pure fruit and a granny smith crunch. Elegant and concentrated. A supreme vintage and one that will reward with cellaring.

**About the Wine** There is a good range of aromas and flavors across a spectrum of ripeness. The 2021 has the potential to be right up there with the best vintages of the last two decades.

**Tasting Notes** Lifted nose of ripe nectarines, apricots, brioche, and toasted hazelnuts with a hint of flinty complexity. The palate displays stone fruits, honeysuckle, and a nutty complexity from the natural ferments.

### Clay Hills Vineyard Pinot Noir 2019



Composition 100% Pinot Noir | SRP \$59.99

**About the Wine** Whole bunch fermentation gives this wine a lifted floral and spice character but without any greenness that can be associated with the style..

**Tasting Notes** The palate is full and fine with cherry fruits and lingering tannins providing a mouth filling and satisfying experience. This is an elegant but expansive wine that is a delightful experience.

### The Paper Nautilus Sauvignon Blanc 2021



Composition 100% Sauvignon Blanc | SRP \$48.99

**About the Wine** The Paper Nautilus illustrates an alternative style to the classic expression of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Named for the Paper Nautilus shells that wash up on beaches in the Marlborough Sounds, these shells are wafer-thin with beautiful geometry and texture.

**Tasting Notes** Intense lifted aromas of passionfruit, lemongrass, and ripe grapefruit. The palate introduces delightful lime zest flavors with mouth-watering intensity finishing with a strong textural component.

## The Paper Nautilus Sauvignon Blanc 2022



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**About the Wine** The Paper Nautilus illustrates an alternative style to the classic expression of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Named for the Paper Nautilus shells that wash up on beaches in the Marlborough Sounds, these shells are wafer-thin with beautiful geometry and texture.

**Tasting Notes** Intense lifted aromas of citrus blossom, lemongrass and green gage plums. The palate introduces delightful citrus-based mouth-watering intensity and finishes with a strong textural component.

TWO PADDOCKS VIDEOS Sam Neill started Two Paddocks in 1993 with modest ambitions to produce a good Pinot Noir that would be enjoyed by family and friends. Although production is still limited, Sam now owns vineyards in all four major sub-regions of Central Otago (Bannockburn, Gibbston Valley, and the Cromwell and Alexandra Basins). In years when the crew believe that the vineyards have produced an extraordinary expression of site, a small single vineyard offering is released: Last Chance and The Fusilier.

"We grow our premium Two Paddocks Pinot Noir entirely on our four small vineyards in Central Otago. In some exceptional vintages, listening carefully, we realize that one of these sites may have something extraordinary to say in its own right. It is only then that we will make one of these very rare single vineyard wines."

**About the Wine** Two Paddocks Riesling is an estate grown, single block selection made from fruit grown at Two Paddocks' Red Bank Vineyard situated in the Earnscleugh district of Alexandra, Central Otago.

**Tasting Notes** Aromas of tart apple, nectarine, citrus and white flowers. Lots of texture and concentration on the pallet with flavors of peach and lime balanced with a steely finish to offer perfect structure.
