ALWEMIST

ALKKEMIST MEDITERRANEAN COAST

Alkkemist Gin is the artisan vision of a 21st century alchemist, passionate about gin and the Mediterranean coast. Made in Spain and distilled under the light of the full moon.

WHERE IT FALLS IN THE WORLD OF GIN

A very fragrant and floral forward gin featuring a base of triple-distilled grain spirit and 21 different botanicals.

Alkkemist Gin

ABV: 40% (80PF) 12/750

Unique botanicals like the Moscatel grape, rock tea, and sea fennel make this a one-of-a-kind gin.



BAYAB AFRICA

Founded by Chris Frederick and Damola Timeyin, Bayab Gin is African from its roots with ingredients sourced from across the African continent, as well as being distilled and bottled in Africa.

WHERE IT FALLS IN THE WORLD OF GIN

The Zambian Baobab fruit's tangy sherbet taste is complemented with bountiful African botanicals then blended with the purest water from the Midlands of KwaZulu-Natal.

Bayab Classic Dry Gin

ABV: 40% (80PF) 12/750

A classic dry with an African twist. The infusion of Zambian Baobab gives this gin a bold burst of fresh African citrus.

Bayab Rose Water Gin

ABV: 40% (80PF) 12/750

A slightly sweeter and more floral gin made with African rose petals and rose water

Bayab Burnt Orange Gin

ABV: 40% (80PF) 12/750

A citrus-forward expression distilled with Marula fruit, baobab fruit, and burnt orange peel





BOOMSMA NETHERLANDS

Now under the care of fifth-generation Chantoine and Saskia Boomsma, Boomsma is the leading producer of the most traditional Dutch spirits like genever.

WHERE IT FALLS IN THE WORLD OF GIN

Not gins but very classic and high-quality genevers, the ancestors of today's gins.

Boomsma Jonge Genever

ABV: 40% (80PF) 12/750

Composed of a blend of wheat, malt and korn spirits. juniper is at the fore, complemented by a touch of lime and mandarin orange

Boomsma Oude Genever

ABV: 40% (80PF) 12/750

This old genever is aged for at least one year in bourbon barrels. This results in its signature taste: soft, intense, and elegant.

FOUR PILLARS

FOUR PILLARS AUSTRALIA

Founded in 2013 in the Yarra Valley of Australia, it took Four Pillars Distillery only six years to be named the International Gin Producer of the Year by the International Wine & Spirits Competition.

WHERE IT FALLS IN THE WORLD OF GIN

This carbon neutral distillery uses sustainable practices to produce a variety of gins, using local botanicals where possible.

Four Pillars Rare Dry Gin

ABV: 41.8% (83.6PF) 12/750

Four Pillars' flagship gin highlights their signature use of whole Australian oranges along with native lemon myrtle.

Four Pillars Navy Strength Gin

ABV: 58.8% (117.6PF) 12/750

This is the most highly awarded gin in its class, made with local botanicals like finger limes, ginger, lavender, and whole oranges

Four Pillars Bloody Shiraz Gin

ABV: 37.8% (75.6PF) 12/750

Four Pillars' take on a sloe gin. Starting with their rare dry gin, they Shiraz grapes giving the gin its deep purple hue.

Four Pillars Olive Leaf Gin

ABV: 43.8% (87.6PF) 12/750

"Best Signature Botanical Gin" at the World Gin Awards; made with three types of cold-pressed, extra virgin olive oil.

J. RIEGER & COMPANY MISSOURI

Closed by Prohibition, Jacob Rieger and Company was then resurrected in 2014 by Jacob's great-great-great grandson Andy Rieger and bartender Ryan Maybee. They are joined by head distiller Nathan Perry and the world-renowned Tom Nichol.

WHERE IT FALLS IN THE WORLD OF GIN

This London Dry style was developed under the mentorship of celebrated Master Gin Distiller, Tom Nichol.

J. Rieger Midwestern Dry Gin

ABV: 46.1% (92.2PF) 12/750

Bright, fresh, and alive with spices and citrus. The palate has a rich and creamy texture with a long finish.

MIRABEAU

MIRABEAU FRENCH RIVIERA

Maison Mirabeau was founded by Stephen and Jeany Cronk, a London couple that moved to Provence to pursue their dream of making rosé wine and now gin. All of their products are handcrafted in France with a deep commitment to the environment.

WHERE IT FALLS IN THE WORLD OF GIN

Mirabeau Riviera Dry Rosé Gin uses a 100% grape-based spirit made from upcycled grape skins which adds roundness and subtle fruitiness to the palate.

Mirabeau Dry Rosé Gin

ABV: 43% (86PF) 12/750

A splash of rosé wine and botanical accents from the French Riviera make this a one-of-a-kind gin.



POLI DISTILLERIE ITALY, VENETO

Artisan producers of fine Italian grappa and spirits, this distillery is solely owned by the Poli family. Founded in 1898 near Bassano del Grappa, Veneto, the distillery is currently run by fourth-generation Jacopo Poli.

WHERE IT FALLS IN THE WORLD OF GIN

Made by distilling twice the amount of juniper than the standard gin and adding mint, basil, rosemary, thyme, cardamom, and coriander. It's modern yet elegant, intense yet refreshing.

Poli Distillerie Marconi 42 Gin

ABV: 42% (84PF) 12/750

"With this Mediterranean-inspired Gin, we want to evoke the feeling of walking by the sea." – Jacopo Poli
